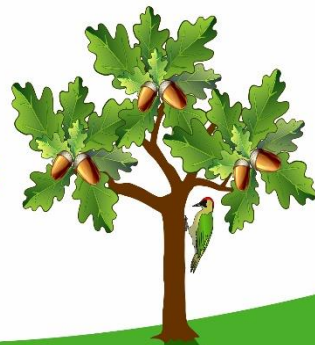

Changes to measures and guidance for managing COVID-19 in education and childcare settings from Friday 1 April

On Tuesday 29 March, the Secretary of State for Health and Social Care, set out the [next steps for living with COVID-19](#) in England from Friday 1 April.

- Pupils with possible Covid symptoms: children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend. The advice is stay at home for at least 3 days.
- People at risk of serious illness from COVID-19, and eligible for treatments, will continue to get free tests to use if they develop symptoms
- For education and childcare settings from Friday 1 April regular asymptomatic testing is no longer recommended in any education or childcare setting
