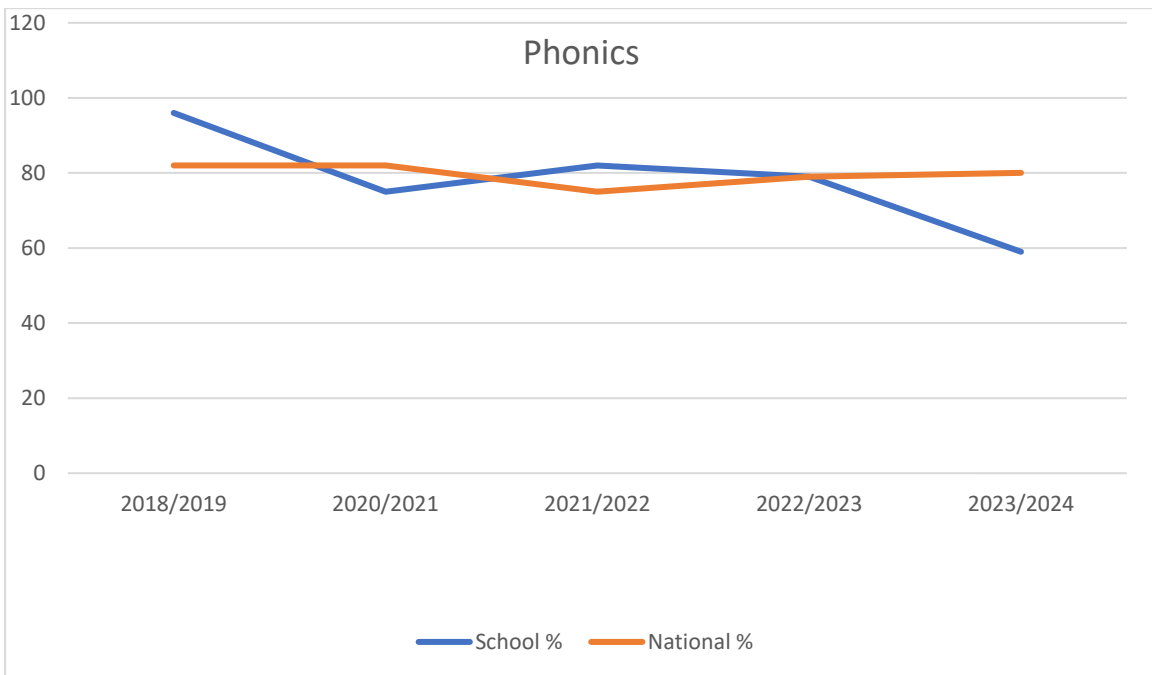
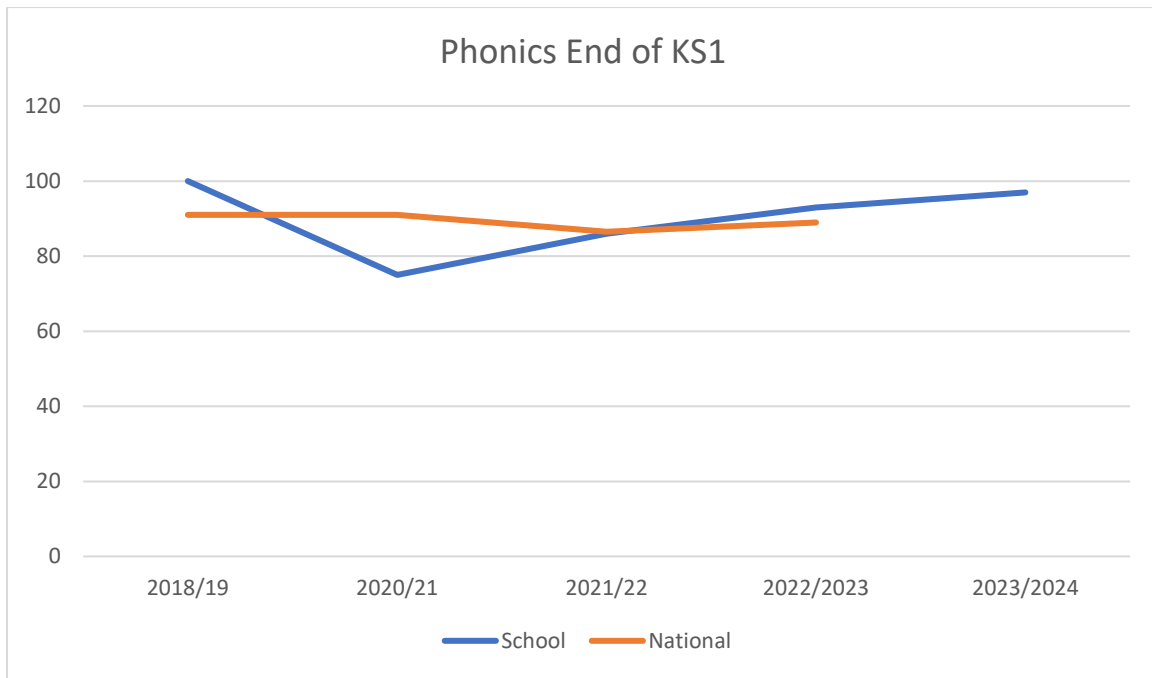


Aside from a slight dip in 2020/2021 (a cohort with high levels of Special Needs), the school continues to achieve stable results and is on an upward trend.

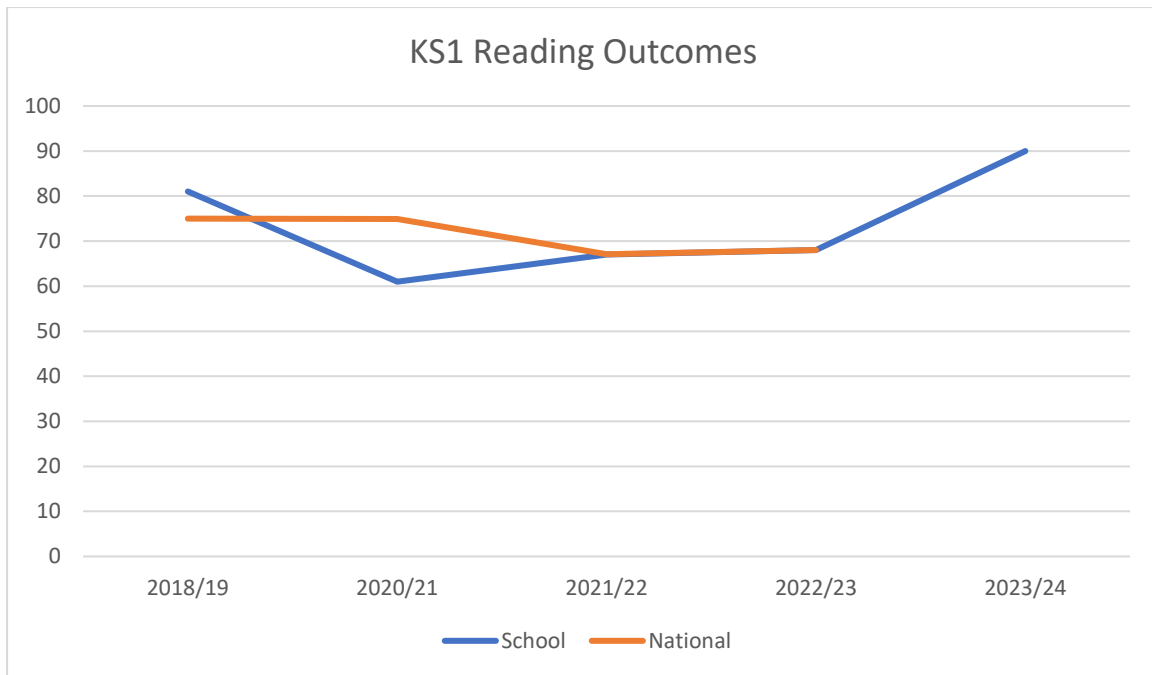


Phonics outcomes at the end of Year 1 have been strong historically. After a drop in 2020 to 2021 Phonics improved in line with National average. In 2024 the attainment level is cohort specific and reflects the number of pupils with additional needs. Pupils continue to have daily Phonics support into Year 2.

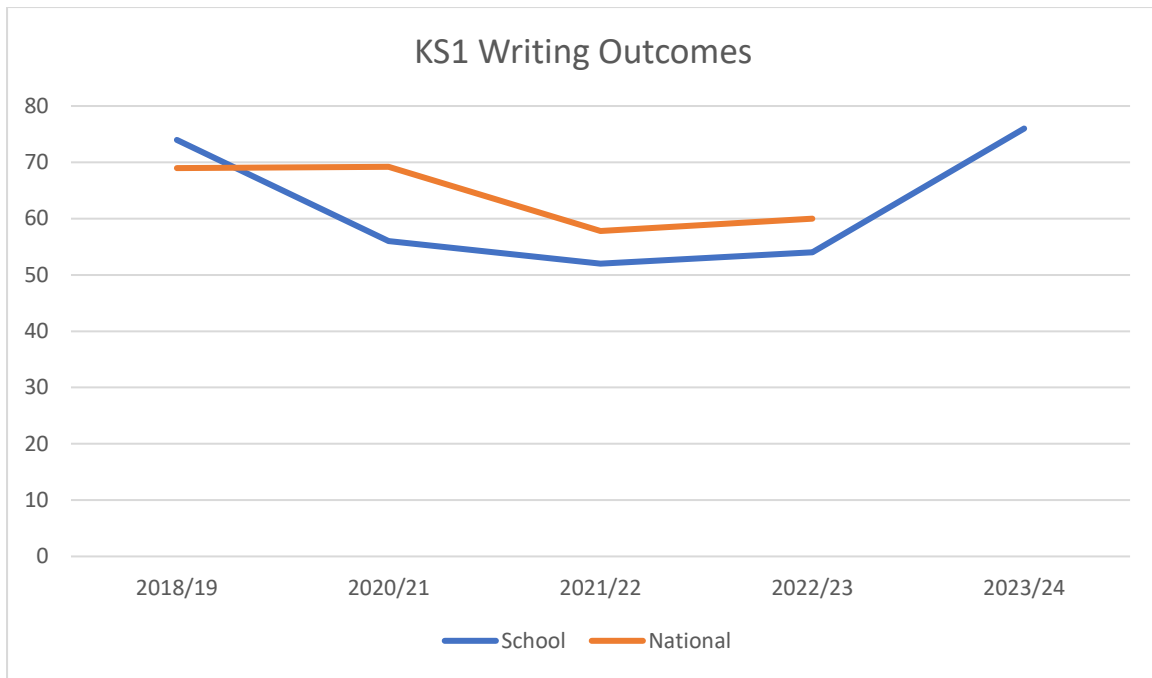




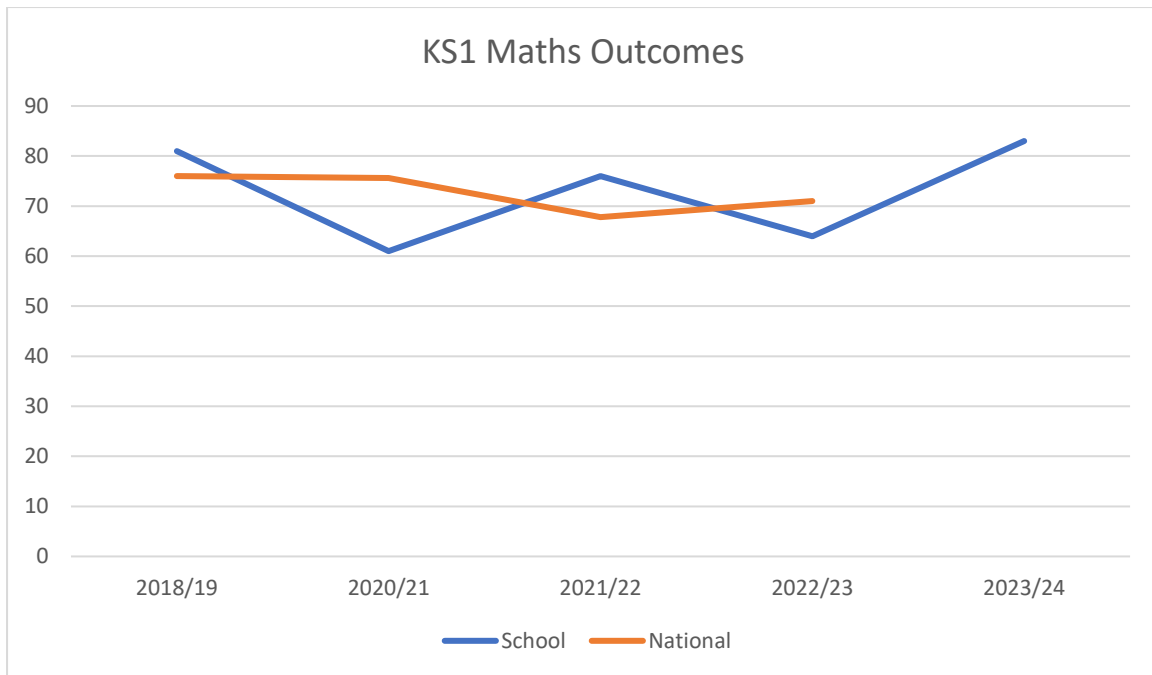
Most pupils achieve the expected standard in phonics by the end of Key Stage 1.



Despite a slight dip in 2020/2021, pupils' attainment in Reading has continued to increase. 2024 Teacher Assessment data shows a significant rise in attainment.



Writing was the area most impacted during the pandemic. 2024 Teacher assessment data shows a steep incline in writing attainment in Year 2.



Attainment in Maths at the end of Key Stage 1 continues to be strong. Although there was a dip in 2020/21 this has now increased and 2024 Teacher assessment data shows a significant increase in attainment.
